

- 1. Resolution Food Service 2020-2021

Metuchen Board of Education Food Service 2020-2021 Management Fee and Guarantee Language

Be it resolved that the Metuchen Board of Education "SFA" approves the renewal of the Food Service Management contract with The Pomptonian, Inc. "FSMC" for the food service operation for 2020-2021.

The FSMC shall receive, in addition to the costs of operation, an administrative/management fee of \$23,395.00 to compensate the FSMC for administrative and management costs. This fee shall be billed in 10 monthly installments of \$2,339.50 per month as a cost of operation. The SFA guarantees the payment of such costs and fee to the FSMC.

The FSMC guarantees the SFA no cost of operation for school year 2020-2021.
