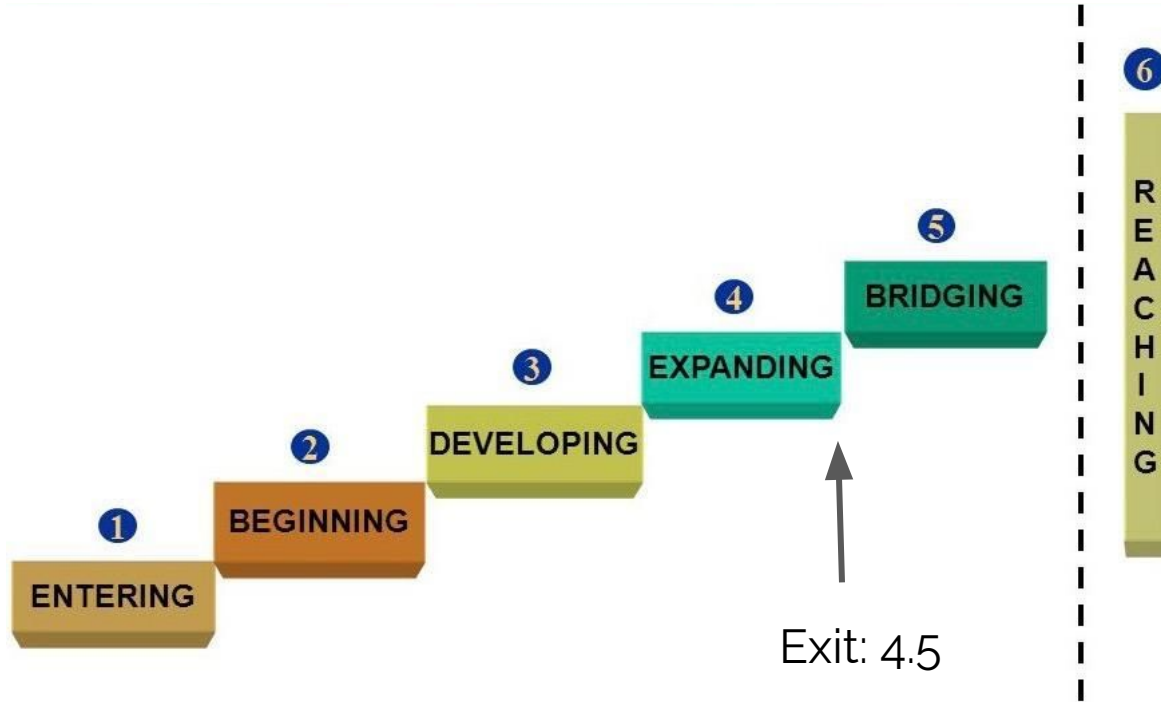

 - Supporting Immigrant Students
- Ongoing training of administrators and school counselors
- Ongoing built in consultation with the ESL Teacher for K-12
- Continuing to offer 10 hour SIOP Course for teachers to support ELLs in classroom
