Mr. Chris Derflinger – SB1055 is floating around the State of NJ to mandate full day kindergarten. If full day kindergarten is mandated by the State, does the State provide funding or does the district have to find the money? According to the State of New Jersey Constitution the State must provide funding for mandated laws, however, the amount of funding is at their discretion. If the amount is not sufficient, the district would have to fund the rest of the mandate.

Ms. April Compatore – representative from the full day kindergarten group asked for a motion to include funds for full day kindergarten staffing and construction question. Why was full day kindergarten funds not included in asking the state for additional funding? The waiver that the district asked the state for doesn't cover the cost of full day kindergarten, it included funding to reduce class sizes.

Ms. Risby – many are disappointed with the board actions tonight to not form the full day kindergarten committee.

Ms. Jessica Leiss – The programs at Moss School are great but the ½ day program doesn't include enough time for the students to play and form lasting relationships.

Ms. April Salazar – supports the full day kindergarten program but is disappointed that the motion for the full day kindergarten committee to be formed to explore possibilities failed.

Ms. Nadia Cheetum – thanked Dr. Caputo for proposing to increase the ½ time counselor position to a full time counselor position at Campbell Elementary School.

Ms. Angela Sielski – thank you for taking into consideration the additional staff needed at Campbell Elementary School. She appreciates all of the hard work.

Ms. Vanessa Pietro – disappointed in the vote not to explore the full day kindergarten committee. Please continue the conversation.

Ms. Carolina Prohodka – please continue the conversation of forming a for full day kindergarten committee.
