## What are SAT College \& Career Readiness Benchmarks?

- Students who meet both Math and EBRW benchmarks have a 75 percent chance of earning at least a C in first-semester, credit-bearing college courses in algebra, statistics, pre-calculus, or calculus as well as in history, literature, social sciences, or writing classes.
- Math Benchmark- 530
- EBRW-480


## Class of 2021 SAT Scores

## Observations:

- $62 \%$ of our seniors took the SAT
- 2021 Mean Score: 1285
- 113 Points higher than NJ mean
- 197 Points higher than the total group
\% Meeting both benchmarks:
MHS: 84\%
NJ: 67\%
Total: 51\%



## SAT: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) Scores

## Observations:

- 2021 MHS Mean Score: 641
- 57 Points higher than NJ mean
- 96 Points higher than the Total Group
\% Meeting benchmark:
MHS: 94\%

NJ: 82 \%
Group: 70\%


## SAT: Math Scores

## Observations:

- 2021 Mean Score: 644
- 101 Points higher than NJ mean
- 56 Points higher than the total group
\% Meeting benchmark:
MHS: 87\%
NJ: 68\%
Group: $53 \%$

## ACT Benchmark and Composite Scores

College Readiness Benchmark Scores-minimum score needed to indicate a $50 \%$ chance of obtaining a B or higher or approximately a $75 \%$ chance of obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding credit-bearing college courses




MHS ACT scores are consistently higher than the state and national scores.
